

Christ Episcopal Church of Woodbury to host Nordic Notes Concert by Chris Falteisek on Friday, November 7.

Christ Episcopal Church will host “Nordic Notes: A concert journey featuring the music and photography of Chris Falteisek,” on Friday, November 7, at 7:00 p.m. at 7305 Afton Road in Woodbury. The Christ Church Choir and parish musicians will add their talents.

Chris Falteisek, Christ Church’s new Minister of Worship, is a composer and recording artist who recently spent a two-month sabbatical in Sweden, Lapland, Norway and Finland. The concert will feature some of Chris’ personal compositions and Nordic favorites, as well as multi-media presentations of Falteisek’s Nordic trip and 150 years of Christ Church’s history.

Falteisek, a native of Prescott, Wisconsin, started playing organ and piano for church as a 6th grader. He currently works in several churches as an accompanist and has composed and recorded 15 albums. His musical performances have taken him to Sweden, Norway and around the United States. Falteisek’s musical style is eclectic and mirrors his love of various historical periods. In his spare time, Chris enjoys genealogy and researching for others, as well as his Czech, Polish, Norwegian and Swedish family history.

The concert will be approximately 75 minutes in length. During the concert, a free-will offering will be taken to help support the Christ Church Music Ministry. Falteisek’s albums will be available for sale and refreshments will follow the concert. Christ Church is handicap accessible.
